What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you
	have with us. This information can include:
	 Social Security number and income
	 Account balances and Payment history
	 Credit history and Credit score
	When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in
	this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday
	business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their
	customers' personal information; the reasons Bank of St. Croix, a Division of United Fidelity
	Bank, fsb chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Bank of St. Croix, a Division of United Fidelity Bank, fsb does not share information with affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Bank of St. Croix, a Division of United Fidelity Bank, fsb does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Bank of St. Croix, a Division of United Fidelity Bank, fsb does not jointly market.
